

The Robert Sorby Sandmaster has been designed to produce a fast and efficient finish to any bowl or platter, without producing the unsightly radial-sanding lines produced by traditional sanding methods. Because it is spinning at high speeds, the life of the abrasive is extended. Not only is all the surface used, but the special grade of abrasive reduces clogging. The Robert Sorby Sandmaster has been fitted with a phosphor bronze bearing. This eliminates the possibility of premature failure caused by dust. It is normal for the head of the Sandmaster to get hot during use due to the high speed that the pad reaches

MAINTENANCE

Always ensure there is a slight gap between bush and main body. Place a spot of oil on bearing before each use.




Use eve protection and dust mask when using the Sandmaster.

SANDING 1500 R.P.M.


Allow the sanding disc to run freely on workpiece with the lathe running at a maximum of 1500 R.P.M.



Keep sanding disc moving over workpiece with minimum pressure to reduce excessive heat build up.




Do not allow the abrasive disc to become smooth as this will over-heat the workpiece and potential damage may occur.



When removing abrasive discs, place thumb over edge of pad to avoid damage to the sponge pad.

FINISHING



By fitting a pigtail mandrel and cotton mop - these are optional extras - the Sandmaster becomes a handy buffing tool. Simply add wax or oil for a fine finish.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Your Sandmaster comes complete with a 2" sanding pad and 2" abrasives in 60, 120, 180, 240 and 400 grit. The following optional extras are available: 2" tapered sanding pad (ref. 412T), 3" sanding pad (ref. 413)

' abrasives in 60, 120, 180, 240 and 400 grit. Pigtail mandrel (ref. 491), ' goblet mop (ref. 492), 3" bowl mop (ref. 493), 4" bowl mop (ref. 494)

The Micro Sandmaster uses a 1" sanding pad and abrasive discs as well as the same interchangeable handle as the other three sets in the Modular Micro system range, a Hollowing set, a Spindle set and a Micro Spiralling set.

This allows for the heads and blades from each set to be fitted into the one handle.

Multi Tip Hollowing Tool (RS200KT) and Hollowmaster (RS230KT)

The Multi Tip Hollowing tool is one of the most versatile tools around and is an invaluable addition to any tool kit. We recommend it as a first hollowing tool for anyone wanting to start their initial hollowing project. It has two replaceable HSS tips which may be used for straight hollowing or can be offset to under-cut in those normally inaccessible places. Fitted with a half-round shank, this tool is especially safe in use. Further versatility is provided by a teardrop scraper cutter. Its shape makes it a square, round, and half-round scraper in one tool. There are additional beading and coving cutters which can also be fitted.

Working in conjunction with the Multi Tip Hollowing Tool is the Hollowmaster. This also features a half-round shank for extra stability and has two interchangeable cutters — a straight one for hollowing and a round for finishing. The Hollowmaster is swan-necked allowing extra access round the corners of vases and other hollows forms.

Smaller scale versions of these two tools are now available for those working on finer projects.

Texturing Tool (310H) and Spiralling System (330H)

Surface texture will enhance the appeal of any turned object. The Robert Sorby Texturing Tool will create a myriad of different patterns on both side- and end-grain from orange peel to sunburst. The Spiralling System enables the turner to add a variety of spirals in different sizes, cross hatches, diamonds and other regular decorations on both spindle and faceplate work.

ProEdge Sharpening System

The ProEdge takes all the guesswork out of sharpening all your woodworking tools and much more. It incorporates a patented, accurate angle setter to ensure the cutting angle of your tool remains consistent. Because the ProEdge system is based on an abrasive belt, tools do not over-heat during sharpening. Belt change could not be easier.
